Minnesota State Colleges and Universities Transfer Profile

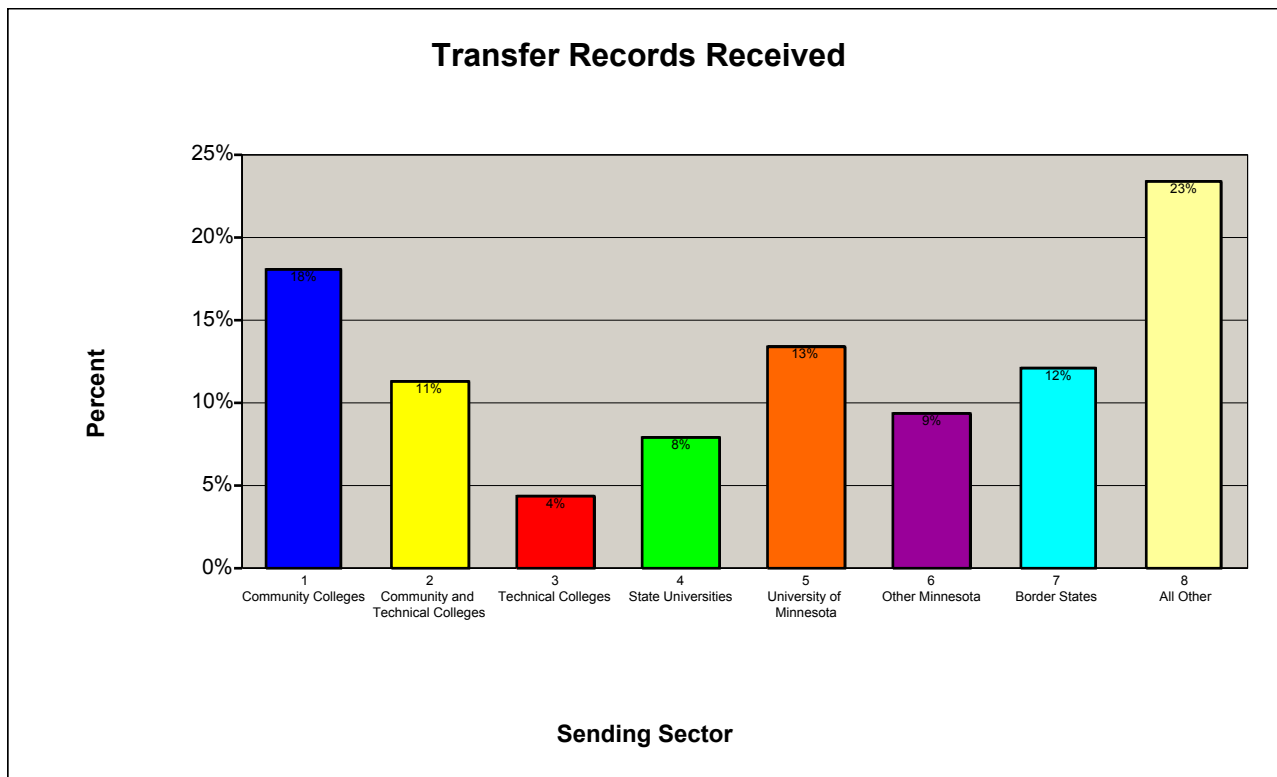
1. *Transfer Receiving and Five Year Summary Chart – Records and Credits* – The number of credits and records received by an institution from all other MNSCU institutions and from institutions outside the system. These are reported individually and by institution sector. A record is the transcript from one sending institution (a student could present multiple transcripts from multiple institutions.) A credit is the total number of credits earned and accepted in transfer from the prior institution divided by 30 to create an FYE credit.
2. *Transfer Sending and Five Year Summary Chart – Records and Credits* – The number of credits and records sent by an institution to all other MNSCU institutions individually and by institution sector. Also included are records sent outside the system, but not credits.
3. *Transfer Receiving Demographics* – The number of unduplicated students who transferred **into** an institution and their gender, age and ethnicity. A student is attached to the sending institution where they transferred the most credits from. If there is a tie, one institution is picked.
4. *Transfer Sending Demographics* – The number of unduplicated students who transferred **from** an institution and their gender, age and ethnicity.
5. *Credit Groups and Records* – The number of records moved per student and number of credits moved per student grouped.
6. *Course Transfer: Credits Accepted in Transfer by **Receiving Institution*** - The percent of credits earned at a sending institution that have been accepted into the receiving institutions. Remedial and other non-degree credits have been subtracted from the total earned credits at the sending institution.
7. *Course Transfer: Prior and Current GPA for Transfer Students by **Receiving Institution*** – The percent of credits accepted at a receiving institution that were earned at the sending institutions.
8. *Course Transfer: Credits Accepted in Transfer by **Sending Institution*** - The percent of credits earned at a sending institution that have been accepted into the receiving institutions. Remedial and other non-degree credits have been subtracted from the total earned credits at the sending institution.
9. *Course Transfer: Prior and Current GPA for Transfer Students by **Sending Institution*** – The percent of credits accepted at a receiving institution that were earned at the sending institutions.
10. *Transfer and Direct Entry Persistence and Graduation Rate* – Persistence and Graduation Rates for students who transferred into an institution compared with direct entry students who were at the same earned credit level as the transfer students when they enrolled at the new institution.
11. *Transfer and Direct Entry GPA* - First term GPA, Last term GPA, Earned Credits at Graduation for students who transferred into an institution compared with direct entry students who were at the same earned credit level as the transfer students when they enrolled at the new institution.
